

Skiers triggered this avalanche on a north-facing slope near the Anger Lake basin. The crown was 4-18 inches deep and propagated the entire width of the gully  $\sim 40$  feet and ran the entire length of the gully  $\sim 500$  vertical feet. The skier was able to ski out of the avalanche right as it broke and was not carried. Photo: Anonymous
