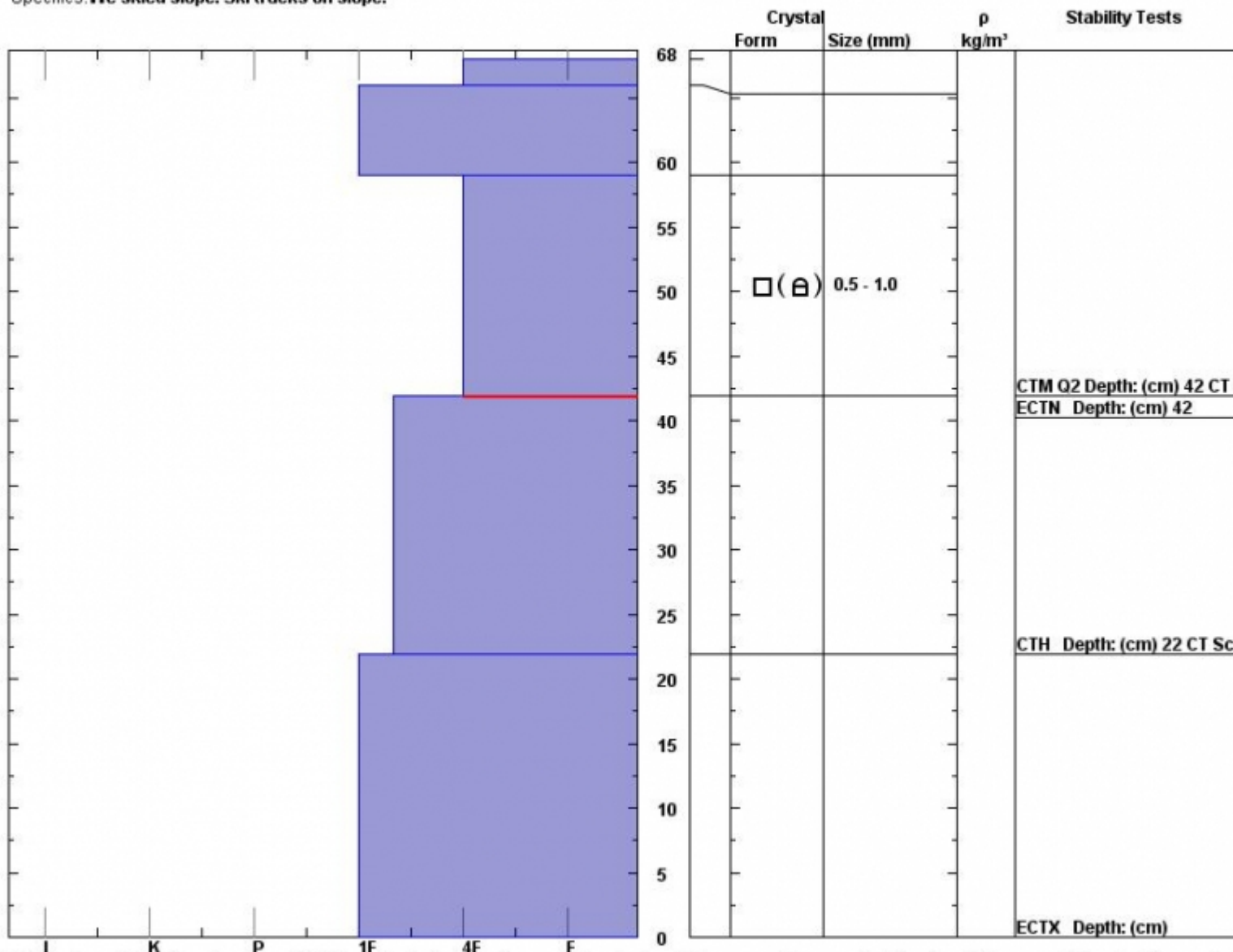

Notes: Surprisingly bomber snow in this location just under the second rock band. More surprising was the faceting in the upper 20 cm's of snow. Surprisingly other locations on northerly aspects had started to facet some during sunny days and clear nights. BBSP has noted similar "recycled powder" that despite the unseasonably warm temps, there continues to be a temp gradient in the snowpack.
